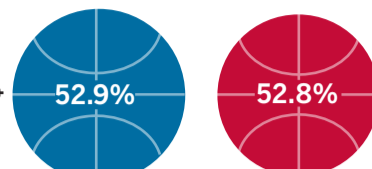

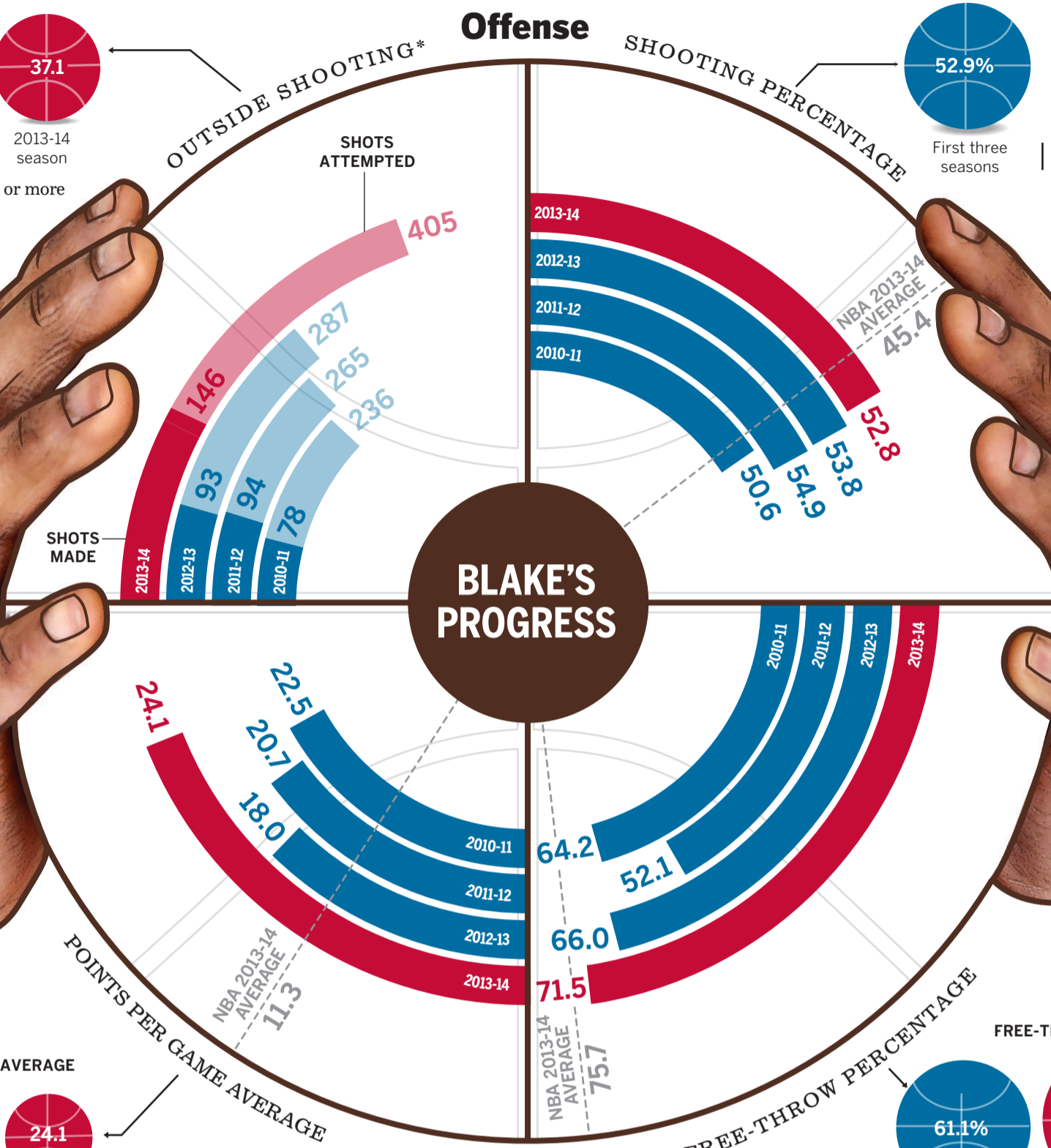

SHOOTING PERCENTAGE

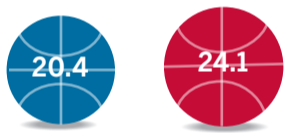

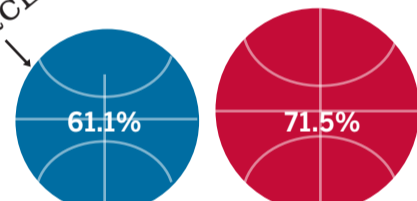


POINTS/GAME AVERAGE

FREE-THROW AVERAGE



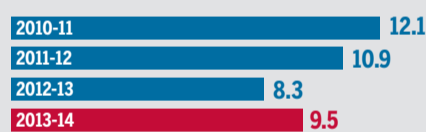

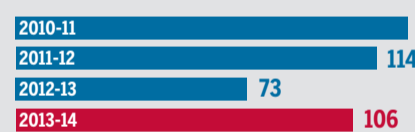

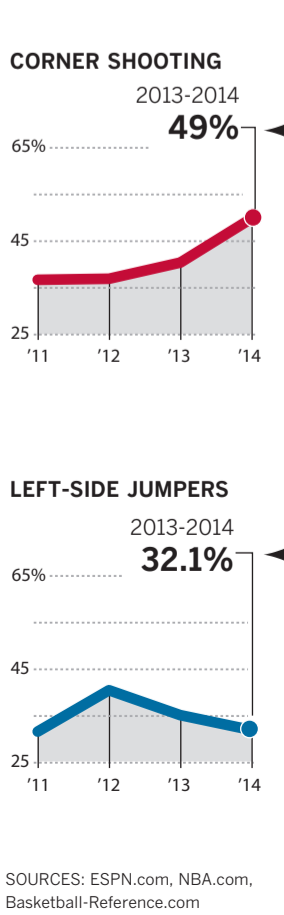
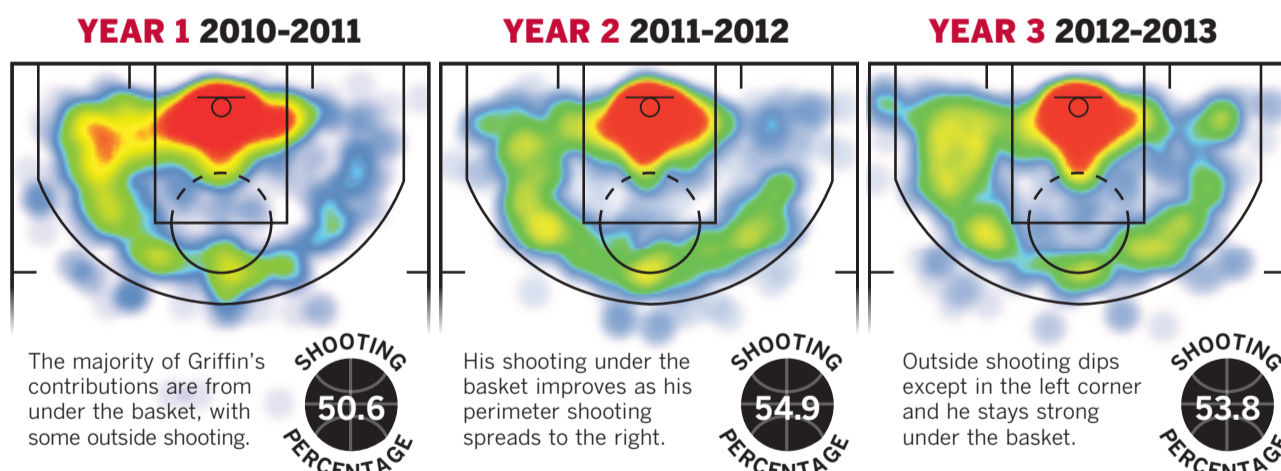

How his shooting evolved

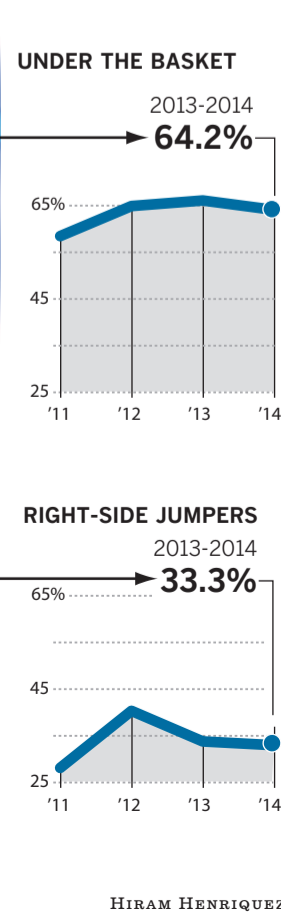
Griffin scored less under the basket this season but scored more from distance, including the top of the key.
